- ✓ It provides practice opportunity for the main types of tasks of the ESP written language exam called 'Theolingua'.
- ✓ The tasks are made up and the texts are selected in a way that they enable the candidates to prepare both for level B2 and for level C1 exams.
- ✓ The tasks are arranged in a format which is similar to the exam task sheets of the real exam situations.
- ✓ The book contains the key to the reading comprehension tasks and sample solutions to the exercises that call for the production of various text types.
- ✓ The letter writing tasks require the language learners to produce texts that are different in tone, so they can practise their skills to use various styles.
- ✓ The appendix – in the form of a short and clear summary that contains demonstrative examples – calls the attention to some key criteria which are worth keeping in mind when writing letters.
